

Announcing the **Barrington Trail Trekker Program!** In the spirit of fun and a continuing desire to get folks enjoying and appreciating the beautiful natural features of the town, the Trails Committee is instituting the Trail Trekker Program.

All you have to do is hike (essentially) all of the public trails in Barrington and you will be emailed a certificate suitable for framing, get a custom made sew-on patch that you can display on your backpack and receive public acknowledgement on the Conservation Commission Facebook page. You will be the envy of all your friends!

There are over 30 miles of trails in the program, so don't expect to complete the program in a weekend. So whether it takes you five days or five years doesn't matter. Find maps at www.barringtonconcom.org to plan your hikes.

It will be done on the honor system (how could we ever prove that you hiked all the trails anyway?), but we ask that you **submit via email at least one photo** of yourself that includes you and some 'iconic' feature of each of the trails or properties listed. Possible photo spots are listed, but you can come up with your own – be creative! **You can submit photos** as you go (barrtrails@gmail.com), along with your name, date and location. With your permission, especially creative or interesting ones will be posted online.
